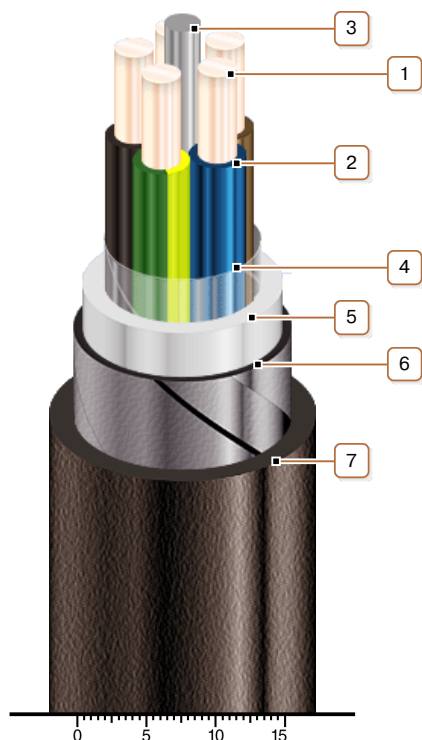

1. Copper conductor
2. XLPE insulation
3. PVC compound bundle
4. PET film winding
5. PVC compound belt insulation
6. Double galvanized steel-tape armour
7. Low flammable PVC compound outer sheath

*Note: Conductor twisting is not illustrated*
